- open beam ceilings
- deep sill windows
- wide board finished flooring
- fieldstone fire place
- bedroom with small fire place
- front and back stairways
- sitting room with fireplace
- living room and dining rooms
- kitchen overlooking a spacious field stone walled patio.
- powder room
- door to dirt floor basement.
- 4 bedrooms and 2 baths on second floor
- master bed room has large walk in closet with built in cabinetry
- door to unfinished attic.
- front and side entrance
- oil hot water heat – 3 years old, elect hot water heater, electric cooking
- well pump recently replaced – 2 months old
- work shop and attached garage
- in-ground pool – pool house
- Supposedly the basement was part of an underground railroad for slaves during the Civil War
